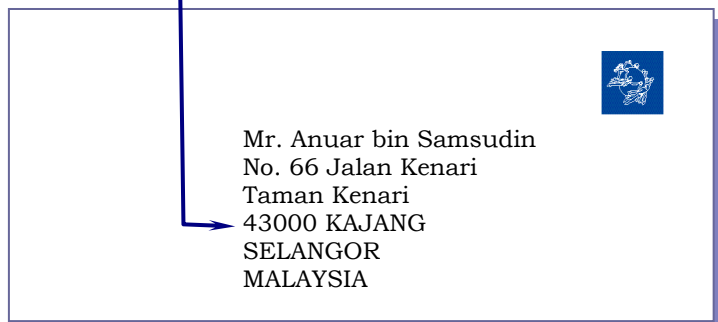
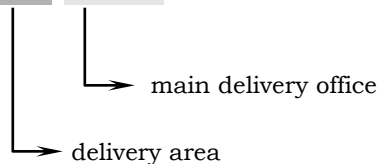

5 digits to the left of the locality name.

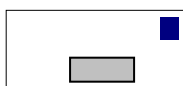

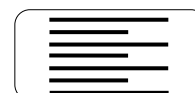
Position of the address on the envelope

Address format

Addresses should be written in the following format:

- line 1: recipient name;
- line 2: house no./lot no./floor and building name;
- line 3: number, street name/district;
- line 4: postcode and locality name;
- line 5: state name (for international communication);
- line 6: country name (for international communication).
